



Entering its 15th year, the Take A Kid to the Game (TAKG) program provides NCAA® member institutions a national grassroots program that is easily implemented at men's and women's basketball games. This nationally-recognized program encourages adults to take children to collegiate athletic contests. Institutions participate by signing up online, selecting an official TAKG game, and offering free or discounted tickets to children fourteen and under when accompanied by a paying adult. The TAKG program allows institutions an opportunity to introduce area youth to its athletics programs as well as the college or university while also boosting attendance.

The Student-Athlete Advisory Committee and the athletic department at Hilbert College are hosting its fifth TAKG program on Saturday, February 13, 2010, when Mount Aloysius College travels to Hamburg for the AMCC double header basketball games. Women's game begins at 1 pm; men's game at 3 pm.
