- 1. Hilbert College is committed to assessment as a unified, clear, and inclusive process for continuously improving the educational outcomes of its students.
- 2. Assessment shall be guided by Hilbert College's mission and liberal learning goals.
- 3. Assessment is a shared responsibility involving faculty, staff, administration and students.
- 4. Assessment findings are most valuable when shared as broadly as possible.
- 5. Student learning is best assessed through a variety of methodologies.
- 6. Consideration of assessment results will lead to improved curricular, planning and budgetary decisions.
- 7. The assessment process must be ethical and fair.
- 8. Assessment findings will not be used for individual faculty or staff evaluation.
- 9. Good assessment shall exist in harmony with academic freedom.
