In other words, students learn how to effectively connect the dots! This course offers a blend of "old school" tips, techniques, and methodology combined with some of the most advanced, comprehensive tools and resources available to the police industry. Uniform officers can immediately put aspects of the course to work as effectively as detectives or criminal analysts. The "Intelligence Cycle" is introduced early in the course and is used throughout the course in a practical case-development project that requires them to apply their new found knowledge.
