Also, the nurse manages the Wellness Center and coordinates educational health programs. Serves as the College's Official Liaison to the New York State Department of Health and the Erie County Public Health Department. Duties to include:

- Responsible for professional, medical treatment of students.
- Responsible for early detection of physical problems and health evaluations.
- Responsible for disease prevention.
- Assists in promoting programs on health-education and immunization.
- Maintains clinical records.
- Coordinates vision, hearing, and orthopedic screening and health assessments.
- Provides emergency aid to students and College staff as needed.
- Assists staff and faculty in instructing students in health and nutrition education.
- Serves as a member and/or leader of health related campus-wide committees.
