1. Complete the enclosed Hilbert Express Application and drop it in the mail using the included return envelope (no stamp needed).
2. List us on your FAFSA (code 002735) and TAP applications (code 2083) to see the full financial benefit of a Hilbert education.
3. Give the enclosed blue card to your high school counselor in order to submit an official copy of your high school transcript.
4. Schedule a campus visit at hilbert.edu/visit. We have in-person and virtual visits available almost every day!

To finalize your eligibility for these benefits, be sure to review your enclosed tuition summary, with a due date of March 31.

Payments can be made by mailing a check/money order or by calling the Student Finance Office at 716-926-8940. There are scholarships available which can fully or partially cover the cost of your tuition.
