- 6. Must have faculty recommendation (signed at bottom of this form)

The course (FS 499) grants 3 credit hours upon satisfactory completion.

Requirements include: One full day (8 hours) at the site or agency for a total of <u>120 hours and one</u> <u>seminar class</u> at Hilbert for 75 minutes per week. Completion of a log/journal and agency workbook will be the basis for a self-assessment and issue paper outlining your experience.
