The Forensic Science/Crime Scene Investigation Department plans to offer FS/CSI Internship positions during the **FALL 2019** semester. The positions are open to **pre-service, full-time, FS/CSI majors only**.

The following criteria must be met by applicants by May 2019.

1. Must have completed 90 credit hours by May 2019.
2. Must have a cumulative QPA of 3.00
3. Must have a QPA of 3.00 in Forensic Science classes
4. Must have completed a minimum of 6 Forensic Science classes
5. Must have an interview with the internship instructor
6. Must have faculty recommendation (signed at bottom of this form)

The course (FS 499) grants 3 credit hours upon satisfactory completion.

Requirements include: One full day (8 hours) at the site or agency for a total of 120 hours and one seminar class at Hilbert for 75 minutes per week. Completion of a log/journal and agency workbook will be the basis for a self-assessment and issue paper outlining your experience.
