**Job Summary:** The Division of Professional Studies is seeking qualified candidates for a full-time faculty member (open rank) with primary teaching responsibilities in the area of Systems Security/Cybersecurity. The successful candidate should also be able to teach a variety of core and elective courses within the Cybersecurity major. Hilbert College will be developing online programs for both undergraduate and graduate degrees. Additional expectations include academic advisement, service to the college, and continued professional development. Faculty appointments are for a ten-month contract period and the normal teaching load is 12 credit hours per semester.

**Requirements/Qualifications:** Minimum qualifications include an earned Ph.D. in computer science, cybersecurity, or a closely-related field. Candidates from all areas of computer science are also encouraged to apply. Applicants in ABD may be considered with the expectation that the Ph.D. will be completed by the start of the Fall 2020 semester.
