Job Summary: The Head Coach is responsible for directing the planning, development, and implementation of all activities related to the program. These areas include, but are not limited to, identify, recruit and retain top prospective student athletes. Coordinate practice planning, skill development, and design coaching strategies which prepare the team for competition. Establish a competitive schedule. Closely supervise practices, meets and all team travel. Manage team budgets while demonstrating fiscal responsibility and support of cost containment initiatives. Oversee equipment and uniform purchases and inventories. Abide by college, NCAA and conference rules and regulations. Collaborate with Marketing and Communications and events staff to promote the team. Serve as a positive role model for all student-athletes.
