The search for the next president of Hilbert College is making great progress. Hilbert's Search Consultant, Kate Haley, has been screening and selecting candidates whose background and experience seem especially consistent with the presidential qualities and qualifications established for the search. The Committee has identified candidates who will be invited to confidential preliminary interviews with the search committee. After that round of interviews, the Committee will select a limited number of candidates to later participate in more extensive interviews on campus with a broad range of Hilbert constituents. We will notify you of the specific dates and times of these visits as soon as they are scheduled, possibly early in the Fall semester.

As a Committee, we are very pleased with the quality of the candidate pool and have every reason to believe that our search will successfully conclude on schedule this fall.
