The LSAT preparation should begin in the spring term of the undergraduate junior year, and the LSAT should be taken in June following the undergraduate junior year. Application to UB Law school is made that fall (see UB application deadline). If accepted into UB Law, the senior curriculum is through UB Law School at UB's campus. A transcript from the first year UB Law School is to be sent to Hilbert College to receive a Bachelor of Science degree. Receipt of this degree is required to continue in the UB program. The final two years of the six-year plan are also at UB Law School. Upon successful completion of the remaining two years, UB awards a Juris Doctor. □
