Application to UB Law school is made that fall (see UB application deadline). If accepted into UB Law, the senior curriculum is through UB Law School at UB's campus. A transcript from the first year UB Law School is to be sent to Hilbert College to receive a Bachelor of Science degree. Receipt of this degree is required to continue in the UB program. The final two years of the six-year plan are also at UB Law School. Upon successful completion of the remaining two years, UB awards a Juris Doctor.
