

Student Right-To-Know Act Disclosures for Hilbert College 2025 Report

The Student Right-To-Know Act requires schools to disclose the following information to students.

1. Completion and graduation rates and, if applicable, transfer out rates for a specific cohort of the general student body. This cohort is of certificate or degree seeking **full-time-first-time** undergraduate students.
2. For schools that offer athletically related student aid, completion or graduation rates and, if applicable, transfer-out rates of students receiving athletically related student aid

COMPLETION AND GRADUATION RATE FOR FALL 2019 COHORT

Hilbert must make available no later than July 1st, 2025, the rates for the fall semester cohort for students that entered Hilbert in Fall 2019.

The completion and on time graduation rate is: 45.1%

The completion and on time graduation rate is the Completers / Graduates divided by the total Fall 2019 Cohort:

Completers/Graduates from the 2019 Fall Cohort = 64

Total (FTFT) 2019 Fall Cohort = 142

Definitions:

Certificate- or degree seeking student:

First-time undergraduate student: an entering undergraduate who has never attended an institution of higher learning

Undergraduate students: students enrolled in a bachelor's degree program, an associate's degree program or vocational or technical program below the baccalaureate level.

Completer/Graduate: A student is counted as a completer or graduate if the student completed his or her program within 150% of the normal time for completion of the program.

Full-time: A student enrolled and attending, maintaining the minimum course load required to obtain full-time status (12 credits)
